


Then, five groups of students wereformed for carrying out this activity. This included poets from Russia, London and India.


Then, the students were asked to note down their lifestyle and family backgrounds and also their language of inscription were taken in to account. It was later followed by a book decoration.


Students found this activity very novel and therefore they accomplished it with great efforts, hard work and enthusiasm.
















# Poem Recitation Competition









